

# EPPO and France's Treasury Cooperate in Fraud Against the RRF

## News

On 17 January 2024, the EPPO and France's Treasury, together with its Inter-ministerial Anti-Fraud Coordination Mission (MICAF), signed a [Working Arrangement](#) to foster the detection of fraud involving the Resilience and Recovery Facility (RRF). In France, the implementation of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan is coordinated by the French Treasury. As a practical measure, the newly established Working Arrangement also includes a template for reporting possible fraud to the EPPO's office in France as well as a handbook.

The RRF is a temporary instrument of the European Commission to finance reforms in and investments by EU Member States from the beginning of the pandemic in February 2020 through 31 December 2026 (→ [euclid 1/2021, 151](#)). The Member States have outlined their plans for reform and investment that are to be subsidised by the RRF fund.
