

Eurojust Extends Administrative Director's Mandate

At the end of June 2026, the College of Eurojust [extended the mandate of its Administrative Director, Vincent Jamin](#), for a further four-year term. The extension comes at a crucial time, as the revision of the Eurojust Regulation is underway.

During his [first term](#) as Administrative Director (→[eucrim news of 12 October 2023](#)), *Jamin* oversaw several key developments for the Agency:

- The launch of the International Centre for the Prosecution of the Crime of Aggression against Ukraine ([ICPA](#));
- The establishment of the Core International Crimes Evidence Database ([CICED](#));
- The creation of the European Judicial Organised Crime Network ([EJOON](#));
- The development of Eurojust's new Case Management System.

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
