On 8 April 2021, Europol published a [warning](#) concerning scams with emails and messages on social media using the name of Europol's Executive Director, *Catherine de Bolle*. Europol emphasized that such correspondence is fake, especially given that its Executive Director would never directly contact members of the public requesting any immediate action or threatening to open a criminal investigation.
