On 3 April 2018, *Dunja Mijatović* took up the post as Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights. A national of Bosnia and Herzegovina, she is the first woman to hold this post, succeeding *Nils Muižnieks* (2012-2018), *Thomas Hammarberg* (2006-2012), and *Alvaro Gil-Robles* (1999-2006).

Ms Mijatović expressed her priority as being the engagement of governments and societies at large in implementing the relevant rules and treaties.
