On 22 September 2020, on the occasion of the High-Level Conference on the EU Strategy on Victims' Rights, Eurojust announced that it would join the newly created Victims' Rights Platform. The platform is the first measure created under the [first EU Strategy on Victims' Rights](#) (see [euclid 2/2020, p. 104](#)), which was adopted at the beginning of the year to provide a forum for discussion. Other partners of the platform include the European Network on Victims' Rights, the EU Network of National Contact Points for Compensation, the EU Counter-Terrorism Coordinator, the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights, and civil society organisations.
