On 1-2 February 2021, the Joint Parliamentary Scrutiny Group on Europol (JPSG) held its [biannual meeting](#) to discuss the revision and strengthening of Europol's mandate. The discussion focused on Europol's handling of large data sets (big data) and included a presentation by the European Data Protection Supervisor (EDPS). Further debates covered topics such as the impact of COVID-19 on the EU's internal security, the role of police cooperation, cybercrime, and digital resilience.
