On 21 March 2018, a joint operation between Slovenia, Kosovo, the European Union Rule of Law Mission in Kosovo (EULEX), and Europol led to the **arrest of 12 migrant smugglers operating in the Balkans**. Over the past year, this organized criminal group smuggled 300 people to Europe, earning an estimated monthly income of €900,000.
