In October 2022, Mr *Torben Thygesen* was appointed Eurojust Representative for Denmark. Prior to joining Eurojust, Mr Thygesen served as Deputy State Prosecutor and Chief Prosecutor in different sections of the Danish prosecution service. He has a wealth of working experience in tackling serious and organised cross-border crime. Thygesen succeeds Mr *Jesper Hjortenberg*, who had served at Eurojust since 2010.

Due to its opt-out in EU legislation in the area of freedom, security and justice subsequent to the Lisbon Treaty, Denmark has no longer been a member of Eurojust since the new Eurojust Regulation came into force in 2019. However, an agreement between Eurojust and Denmark foresees that Denmark can second a representative to the agency.
