On 26 July 2019, the [No More Ransom initiative](#) celebrated its third anniversary. Today, the portal offers decryption to 109 different types of ransomware infections and is available in 35 languages. 150 partners, consisting of 42 law enforcement agencies, 5 EU Agencies and 101 public and private entities, have joined the initiative since its start in July 2016 (see [euclid 3/2016](#), p. 128).
