The Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly (PACE) elected Professor *Anja Seibert-Fohr* as **new judge to the European Court of Human Rights** on 27 July 2019. Her term of nine years commenced on 1 January 2020. Professor *Anja Seibert-Fohr* succeeds Professor *Angelika Nußberger* who has been serving as judge at the European Court of Human Rights for Germany since 2011. *Seibert-Fohr* was a member of the Human Rights Committee from 2013 to 2017. Since 2016, she has held the chair of Public Law, International Law and Human Rights at the University of Heidelberg.
